This is a polite reminder to everyone out walking to please stay on footpaths across private land and to keep dogs under control at all times.

Last month, an incident occurred in which our young cattle escaped through a broken fence into the woods (by the village) and ended up on our neighbours' land amongst their cattle. This caused a considerable amount of distress to everyone involved- animals and humans alike- with it taking hours to sort, contain and return the cattle back home. A special thank you must be given to everyone who helped and stopped the cattle from getting on to the main road.

On inspection the barbed wire fencing, that runs alongside the woods in question, had been cut in order to gain access into the woods away from the footpath. Thus, please stay on the official footpath that runs along the end of the woods rather than using unofficial access points.
